



HSA Maintenance and Care Manual

Please use the following questions as a tool to identify your agency's knowledge of our products and maintenance needs:

- Has your water safety agency had a PWC program in the past?
- If so, does the program cover equipment, maintenance and service?
- If not, you should consider assigning to role to an individual who is capable of leading your PWC program and maintenance, which includes HSA rescue boards and hardware.
- How frequently does your agency maintain and review PWC gear?

In order to prolong and maintain the quality of our boards, we strongly encourage:

- Purchasing our HSA [Mount Kit](#) for ALL PWCs using our rescue boards in order to avoid potential damage to boards and obtain an ideal fit for integration.
- Observe tension on three points of contact regularly



- Educate customer when board is not in use. Please store boards out of direct sunlight to avoid exposure to UV damage.
- If board is on ski, in direct sunlight for prolonged periods of time, use our HSA [Board Cover](#) and face cover upright into the sun



- Store board on black molded nose cone when on hard surfaces to prevent damage, scratches or delamination on bottom slick skin
- Develop a maintenance schedule for boards to ensure all integral parts are in proper condition for rescue
- Depending on frequency of use, it is recommended to replace bungees once a year or as needed.
- Encourage customers to have a back-up board in fleet to support board repairs
- Familiarizing yourselves with common wear and tear issues will not only make you aware of how these boards are being used (or misused) but the rate at which these damages occur and a realistic timeline to replace product.
